Local Library Donation Policies (as of 2/24/23)

NOTE: Please contact the library BEFORE bringing them your donations in case their policies have changed.

<u>Augusta McKay</u> - Accepts donations between January and the third week of May. Book sale is in June. They try to limit the number of books per donor* and screen for damage, age, etc. (*They are more lenient with frequent patrons.)

Comstock - Accepts CDs, DVDs, books and other materials that are in good condition. Ask patrons to call before bringing in items.

<u>Galesburg</u> - Limits donations to the summer months and does not accept VHS, encyclopedias, text books, or damaged items.

<u>Parchment</u> - Accepts clean books and complete puzzles, no limit per donor. Does not accept magazines, pamphlets, CDs, DVDs, tapes or audiobooks. Book sale is in March from 9am-12pm, with an early bird period at 8am for \$2, and "fill a tote bag* for \$2" period between 12pm-1pm. (Tote bags for sale at the library for \$8 and can be filled for free. Go Parchment!)

Kalamazoo Public Library - To donate call their Friends Of the Library 269-553-7950

<u>Portage</u> - Has no limit to the amount they take for donation. If a lot you can take the donation to the back loading dock. They won't take readers digest or encyclopedias.
