



Richland Community Library will **open to patrons on Tuesday, September 8, 2020** with capacity limitations of 25%. We will no longer take nor require appointments for 30 minute browsing.

What does that mean for our patrons? The 25 percent capacity includes staff on duty; therefore, for upstairs browsing, we can accommodate **10 patrons at a time**, and in our children's area, that capacity is **limited to 5 people**. Due to the more limited space in the children's area, we will offer seating/waiting on our outdoor patio or in the walkway to the children's room.

**Precautions**, which meet health department guidelines, have been established for staff and patron safety:

- Masks covering nose and mouth are required.
- Visits up to 30 minutes are welcome.
- Public computer sessions are limited to one hour (unless arranged prior to visit)
- Children's play areas and activities will be closed.
- Community room will be closed.
- Building occupancy is limited to 25 percent of regular capacity.
- Social distancing guidelines are marked throughout the building.

We would be thrilled to see more of you again; however, we understand that curbside service might be preferred for the time being.
